

Play a round for charity

Northeast Health Wangaratta holds its sixth annual Latipsoh Charity Golf Day at Jubilee Golf Club on Sunday, August 31.

The day will consist of four member teams playing an Ambrose format.

The early bird entry fee per team will be \$100 until Friday, August 15, rising to \$120 for entries received after that date.

Cost includes your golf and a complementary barbecue lunch with drinks available for purchase on the course.

There are a number of prestigious awards and great prizes up for grabs in the categories: winning team (perpetual trophy); runner-up team; third, fourth and fifth placed teams; longest drive (men and women); nearest to the pin on all par threes (men and women); NAGA team award; and best dressed team.

Since the inaugural Latipsoh Day in 2002, the appeal has raised more than \$600,000 for participating hospitals and health services.

Last year, NHW received more than \$16,000 worth of equipment for the oncology unit.
