HoNOS	Health of the Nation Outcome Scale	Clinician	SYMPTOMS
LSP-16	Life-Skills Profile (16 items)	Clinician	DISABILITY
FOC	Focus of Care	Clinician	CONTEXTUAL INFO

HoNOS Items & Sub-scales

Clinician Rated from “0” No Problem to “4” Severe Problem within the last two weeks

1. Overactivity, aggression, agitation
2. Non-accidental self-injury
3. Problem drinking or drug-taking

BEHAVIOUR

4. Cognitive problems
5. Physical illness or disability problems

IMPAIRMENT



6. Hallucinations/delusions
7. Problems with depressed mood
8. Other mental and behavioural problem

SYMPTOMS

9. Problems with relationships
10. Problems with activities of daily living
11. Problems with living conditions
12. Problems with occupation and activities

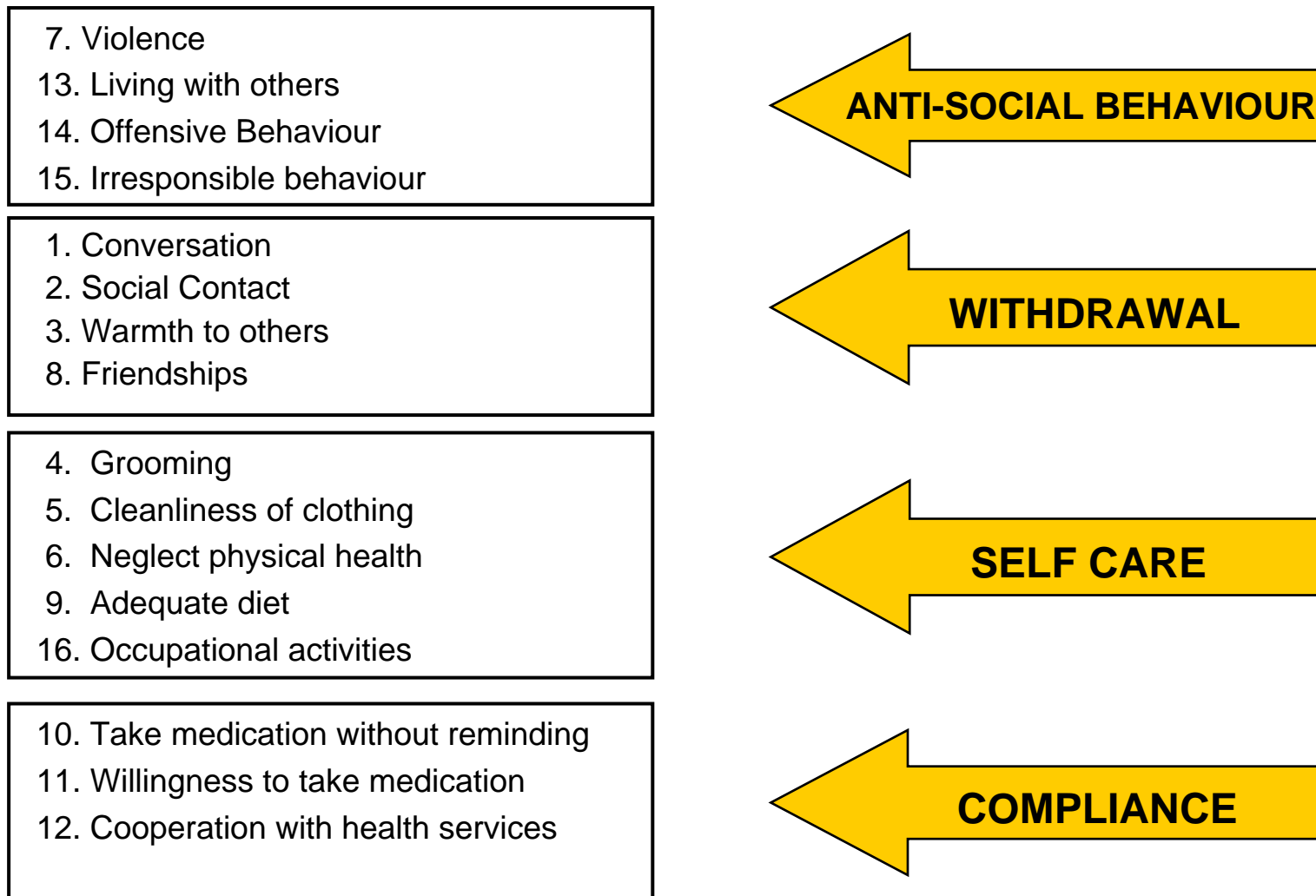

Treatment/Management Planning HoNOS Clinical Prompt				Monitor?	Active Treatment or Management plan?
 Not Clinically Significant	0	no problem	Problem not present	no	no
	1	minor problem	Requires no formal action, may or may not be recorded in clinical file	maybe	no
 Clinically Significant	2	mild problem	Warrants recording in clinical notes, may or may not be incorporated in Care Plan	yes	maybe
	3	moderate problem	Warrants recording in clinical file, should be incorporated in care plan	YES	YES
	4	Severe /very severe problem	Most severe category for consumers with this problem. Warrants recording in clinical file, should be incorporated in care plan (<i>person can get worse</i>)	YES	YES

Clinician Rated from “0” No difficulty to “3” Extreme difficulty average over the last three (3) months



BASIS-32 Items & Sub-scales

Consumer Rated from “0” No difficulty to “4” Extreme difficulty over the past two weeks
